This allows the pistol to be carried in and withdrawn from a pocket quickly and smoothly without snagging.Some were issued to US Army and US Air Force general officers from World War II through the 1970s; these were replaced in 1972 with the RIA Colt M15 general officers model, a compact version of the M1911A1. 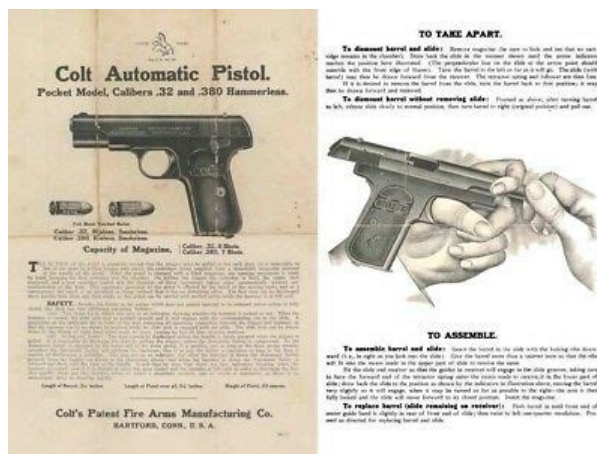
They were issued with a finegrade leather holster, leather pistol belt with goldmetal clasp, rope pistol lanyard with goldmetal fittings, and leather twopocket ammunition pouch with goldmetal fasteners. They came in russet or black leather depending on service and regulations and were made by Atchison Leather Products or Hickock. At that point, they were substituted with .32 models until their replacement in 1972. This is a Colt US Armament reprise of the 1903 pocket model. For the revolver, see Colt M1905 New Marine. The United States military tested the design against other semiautomatic pistols by European makers, and adopted some versions for trial use. The M1900 and variants were also offered commercially. In the Browning design, the slide fitted into rails in the frame, and was integral with the bolt. The barrel rode in locking grooves machined into the interior of the slide, but attached to swinging links secured to the frame, one at the front and one at the rear. When the slide is forward i.e., in battery, the length of the links holds the barrel up, locking it securely into matching grooves in the slide.

Upon recoiling, the barrel and slide move backwards a short distance, locked together, until the arc of the links pulls the barrel downwards, disengaging it from the slide and halting its rearward motion. The barrel then stops moving, while the slide continues rearwards, extracting and ejecting the fired cartridge case and then returns forward, loading a fresh cartridge from the magazine. The barrel is caught, and moved forward with the slide, the camming action of the links lifting it again to lock into the matching grooves. This is identical to the modern style of short recoil action as developed for the later M1911, with the exception of employing both front and rear links, which causes the whole barrel to remain parallel to the slide as it drops out of the locking grooves. The M1911, and most other pistols since, found that it was only necessary to use a single rear link and locking grooves in the rear. When the slide retracts, only the rear of the barrel is dropped, causing it to tilt relative to the slide, while a fixed barrel bushing holds the front of the barrel in place when the slide is in battery, yet allows for movement of the slide and barrel. When pushed down the safety blocked the firing pin, when pushed up it performed as the rear sight. This gave an immediate visual indicator of whether the safety was on or off when one went to aim the pistol, without resorting to feeling for the safety lever. The first 1900s were equipped with rear milled slide grooves but when it was found that this could interfere with the sight safety one could inadvertently flip the safety on or off while manipulating the slide the milled slide grooves were moved to the front. This safety was used in about the first 3,000 production pistols. Colt then installed a conventional rear sight and eliminated the sight safety although the cut in the slide remained but was plugged. The grooves, remained in the front of the slide.

There are earlier sight safety M1900s that were factory retrofitted with the new fixed sight. Although Colt considered a new firing pin safety mounted on the left side of the slide with one prototype, it did not produce such a model. This was a major complaint of the military when they

tested it, something Colt was for some reason loath to fix in the 190019021903 series of pistols. The only exception was the new small sized Colt 1903 Pocket Hammerless, a completely new design with a grip and frame thumb safety at the start of production in 1904. By contrast, Mauser C96 s and Lugers had manual thumb safeties from the outset. Stub hammers may also possibly show up in some retrofitted earlier pistols. Numbers at this time can only be considered approximate. Collectors need to continue to post and communicate observations of surviving pistols. Ergonomics were considered very important, as the pistol was intended for use by cavalry, which meant it had to be readily operated and reloaded from horseback. The Colt had a number of initial problems, due to ill fitting parts in the trigger mechanism, which eventually required the attention of a manufacturers representative, who fitted a new trigger mechanism. Once this was done, the pistol fired the remaining 293 rounds of the 500 allotted for the endurance test, plus an additional 150 rounds with no malfunctions. The pistol fired all ten rounds with no malfunctions during the dust test. After accelerated rusting with sal ammoniac, the pistol was frozen so that the slide would not move. A sharp blow on the edge of a table with the slide freed it enough to allow the slide to operate, and a round to be chambered. After firing the first round, the slide failed to return to battery, but was readily closed, and the remaining rounds functioned without malfunction. A 900round trial resulted in only two failures, both misfires due to defective primers. Additional ammunition was procured, and testing continued.

During this testing, a number of link pins were also broken, and in one case continued firing with a broken rear link caused the barrel to separate just behind the front link pin. After firing a total of 5,800 rounds through the pistol, the only significant problem found was the weakness of the link pins, which was considered readily fixed by the ordnance board. While by today's standards Colts allsteel Pocket Hammerless might seem a bit large and hefty for a pistol chambered in .32 or .380, during its heyday it was considered to be both handy and effective, even when pitted against such world standards as the 1910 Browning and the line of Walther PPS and PPKs. His premier piece, a great pistol in its own right, was the Belgianmade Model 1900 FN Browning. Based on his 1897 patents, the gun was slightly tweaked by Fabrique Nationales designers and then successfully peddled by that firm. It was popular enough to allow the 1900 to be initially adopted by the Belgian government and to be chambered in scads of European, American

and Asian handguns. Over 700,000 were made in .32 and .380 between 1905 and 1945. This one was built in 1920. Though Colt had made its reputation on revolvers, just before the turn of the 20th century, company executives realized the auto pistol was going to be important and began looking at designs and chumming up with promising inventors — including John Browning. Production ceased after 3,500 were made. It was decided that an attenuated version of the 1902 could be marketed as a pocket pistol, so a year later the Model 1903 Hammer auto appeared. Also chambered in .38 Rimless, this seven shooter, at 31 ounces, was not particularly light weight, and as it was really not much more than a bobbed version of the boxy fullsize service pistol, its advantages as a hideout gun were somewhat compromised. It did have the advantage of a reasonably effective chambering, however. They were generally Parkerized and had U.S. ownership marks. This one was made in 1942. Standard finishes were either blue or nickel, and grips were of hard rubber emblazoned with a rampant colt, checkered walnut being offered later on. The barrel length was originally 4 inches, but this was altered to 3 inches in 1908.

In fact, over its lifetime, the Pocket Hammerless experienced a number of changes, now recognized by collectors as five distinct subvariations. Type I up to 1908 had a separate barrel bushing and a 4inch barrel. Type II 1908 to 1910 retained the separate barrel bushing but had a 3inch barrel and .380 chambering was introduced. Type III 1910-1926 introduced the integral barrel bushing. Type IV added a magazine safety. Type V were World War II vintage pistols, the majority of which were Parkerized. Perhaps its only drawback was the rather anemic .32 ACP chambering. This was corrected in 1908 when Colt offered the gun in the more powerful .380 ACP round, a cartridge specifically developed by John Browning for this pistol. Over its career, many highly embellished examples of the pistol were produced, with fancy engraving and finishes, gold inlay and exotic grip material being shown to excellent advantage. Civilian sales for the pistols were brisk, though some law enforcement agencies also procured them. Two of the Pocket Hammerless models more ardent admirers were the gangster Al Capone and the bank robber John Dillinger. As early as World War I, the British purchased several thousand from Colt, following this procurement with another batch in 1921 because of the troubles in Ireland. Thousands were also lendleased to the UK during World War II. Officially and unofficially, the Model M found itself in the hands of military men the world over. Japanese officers were particularly fond of the little pistol, and many were purchased through officers clubs. While foreign purchases and knockoffs accounted for much military employment of the Pocket Hammerless, during World War II the U.S. military made copious use of the handy little pistol. Some 20,000 in both .32 and .380 were issued to specialized personnel and various agencies — most notably the CIA's precursor, the Office of Strategic Services OSS between January 1942 and December 1945. Other than that, the pistols were much the same as one would purchase off a dealers shelf, standard markings and checkered walnut grips. In 1944, it was decided that the Pocket Hammerless in .380 would make an apt general officers pistol, and it soon began to be issued. Probably the two most famous examples are the ones issued to Dwight D. Eisenhower and George S. Patton. Both rounds were designed by John Browning. There was also a double magazine pouch. In 1950, the setup, as a configuration remaining essentially the same, had its color changed to black. The Model M in .380 was issued to generals until the supply ran out in 1950, after which time .32s were substituted until the Pocket Hammerless was finally replaced all together in 1972 by the .45 caliber Rock Island M15. Officially, production ceased in 1945, though guns were available for a time until supplies ran out. But that, as they say, is not the end of the story. The Pocket

Hammerless lives on in U.S. Armaments recently introduced 1903. Colt has officially licensed the design for manufacture once again. Reliability was superb and groups were quite good.
